

## Rules for Competition for a '**Poster for Independence'** (hereinafter referred to as the **Rules**)

- 1. The Rules regulate the following matters:
  - terms for participation in the 'Poster for Independence' competition (hereinafter referred to as the **Competition**) for independent design and creation of a poster illustrating the 100th anniversary of Poland's independence (hereafter referred to as the **artwork**);
  - b) evaluation criteria for the artworks;
  - c) rules for rewarding the winners of the Competition; and
  - d) terms for organisation of the post-competition exhibition.
- 2. The Competition is organised by Ancien Cinema asbl with its seat in Vianden, 23, Grand-rue, L-9410, in Grand Duchy of Luxembourg, hereinafter referred to as the **Organizer**.
- 3. The purpose of the Competition is as follows:
  - a) to raise awareness of young artists about the Polish independence themes;
  - b) to promote the idea of independence, Polish representations and the notion of freedom in a modern artistic form;
  - c) to select the most interesting art submissions for the Competition and to present them at the post-competition exhibition;
- 4. The Competition is open to artists who are 18 years old and older, including professional artists, students and graduates of art schools and other schools and art courses.
- 5.1. The following conditions shall be met in order to participate in the Competition:
  - a) to be acquainted with, and accept, the terms of these Rules;
  - b) that the artwork is the result of the participant's own work;
  - c) delivering artwork in a digital form to the Organizer's email address by **30 June 2018**.
- 5.2. By submitting an artwork in the Competition a participant is deemed to have accepted these Rules.
- 6. Artworks submitted to the Competition must be in a form of an image that can be printed on a paper in a format of a poster of a minimum size of B2. The following are acceptable formats of digital files: jpg, pdf, png, tiff. There Rules do not limit the number of artwork that one artist can submit.
- 7.1. Each artwork shall be submitted electronically to the following address:

with annotation / subject of the message: 'Poster for Independence'



- 7.2. Together with any file containing the artwork, a declaration filled and signed by the participant (hereinafter referred to as the **Declaration**) shall be attached to any e-mail correspondence addressed to the Organizer to include the name and address of the participant and his/her consent to participate in the Competition and the agreement to the terms of these Rules.
- 7.3. The declaration is available for download as a .pdf file from the Organizer's website.
- 8.1. The artworks that meet the requirements of these Rules will be assessed by the Competition Commission, hereinafter referred to as the **Committee** whose composition shall be determined by the Organizer. From among such artworks, the Commission will select the winner of the Competition and the winners of the second and third prizes. The Commission may also award distinctions.
- 8.2. The Commission has the right to decide not to give any award had it considered that the artworks submitted do not represent appropriate artistic merits or do not meet the requirements or the expectations of the Organizer.
- 8.3. The decision of the Commission shall be final.
- 9.1. The winner of the Competition, the winners of the second and third prizes, and the persons awarded any distinctions will be referred to as the Laureates in total.
- 9.2. The winners will be selected by the Commission by applying the following criteria:
  - a) compliance of the message contained in the artwork with the topic of the Competition;
  - b) originality of form and content;
  - c) artistic qualities (including composition, color range, technique of performance).
- 10. From among the submitted works, the Commission will award the following prizes:
  - a) First Prize of EUR 500 (five hundred euro);
  - b) Second Prize in the amount of EUR 300 (three hundred euro);
  - b) Third prize in the amount of EUR 150 (one hundred and fifty euro).
- 11.1. The results of the Competition will be announced and the Laureates will be notified by July 15, 2018.
- 11.2. All awarded with prizes or distinctions will be presented at the post-competition exhibition, which will take place from August 4 to September 9, 2018 at the Ancien Cinéma in Vianden.
- 12.1 By participating in the Competition the participant is deemed to undertake not to make any claims to the Organizer and any persons to whom the Organizer has made available any artwork of such participant, for or related to the use or non-use of the participant's work, in particular any claims for a breach of any property or personal rights of the participant.



12.2. The Laureates of the Competition agree to the publication of his/her image, name and surname along with biographical data and the artwork s/he has created as part of the promotion of the Competition and the Organizer's activities.
